As a quick refresher, Light Duty Pathway offers two products:

- **Light Duty Job Seats** provide injured employees a structured, low-impact job while they recover. This helps reduce time-loss claims, lower workers' comp costs, and keeps employees engaged—whether they're on-site or at home.
- **Video Library Seats** offer standalone access to select LDP videos. These can be assigned individually as supplemental training for any employee—**injured or not.**

Recent Updates & Fixes!


Auto-Generated Passwords

You no longer need to come up with a password for your employees when setting up their accounts. We now generate one for you automatically. You still have the option to change the starter password if you'd prefer.

Welcome Email Warning

We now display a warning if a welcome email won't be sent when you create an employee account. This happens if the username is not a valid email address *and* no team contact is selected.


A welcome email is not strictly required—you can still note the username and password to give to the employee. And if the password is forgotten, it can be reset later.

Entered the wrong email address?

If you accidentally used the wrong email address or had a typo in the email address when assigning light duty, you have two options:

[1] From the personnel page, delete the employee account and add it again. If the employee has not completed any activity, the seat will be emptied and will be available to be assigned again.

NOTE: Only do this if the employee has not yet completed any activity

[2] Contact LDP support and request that we change the username/email for you. The employee will need to use the corrected email address to log in, and an updated welcome email will NOT be sent automatically, so you may need to give them their updated login credentials.
